



A Delicious Chaoshan Delicacy: Hongtaoguo (红桃粿)

As one of Chinese historical areas located in southeastern Guangdong Province of China, Chaoshan area is not only blessed with its cultural legacies, but also with numerous local delicacies. One of them called Hongtaoguo is of great significance to the local people.

Actually, Hongtaoguo is not a household staple food in Chaoshan families, but a common sacrifice offered to the ancestors in important traditional Chinese festivals and on many celebration occasions. It is named after Hongtaoguo according to its shape and color, as it looks like a peach in red color that symbolizes good luck and happiness.

Most of the housewives in Chaoshan area know how to make it and my mom is no exception. Although the process of making can be quite dull, my mom usually spends long hours making it with great patience. There are six key steps in making Hongtaoguo. Firstly, it is necessary to make adequate preparations. In other words, people should select all the necessary ingredients, including mushrooms, sausages, peanut, flour and sticky rice. The next step is to pour enough water into the flour to make the shell of Hongtaoguo. What calls for special attention is that the shell cannot be



too thick, otherwise it would spoil its taste. Apparently, a small amount of chemical substance should be used to redden the shell. Then, it is time to mix and stir-fry the ingredients. When all the ingredients are ready, people can start to make the Hongtaoguo, which is the similar process of making dumplings. That is, to put the ingredients in the shell and wrap them up. In addition to that, it needs to be placed into a plastic peach-shape mold. Lastly, We just need to stream it for about 15 minutes and it's ready to serve.

It is no exaggeration to say that Hongtaoguo has become an indispensible part in Chaoshan people's lives as well as part of our memories. I do wish that the local food would help people gain the insights of the traditional local culture.




