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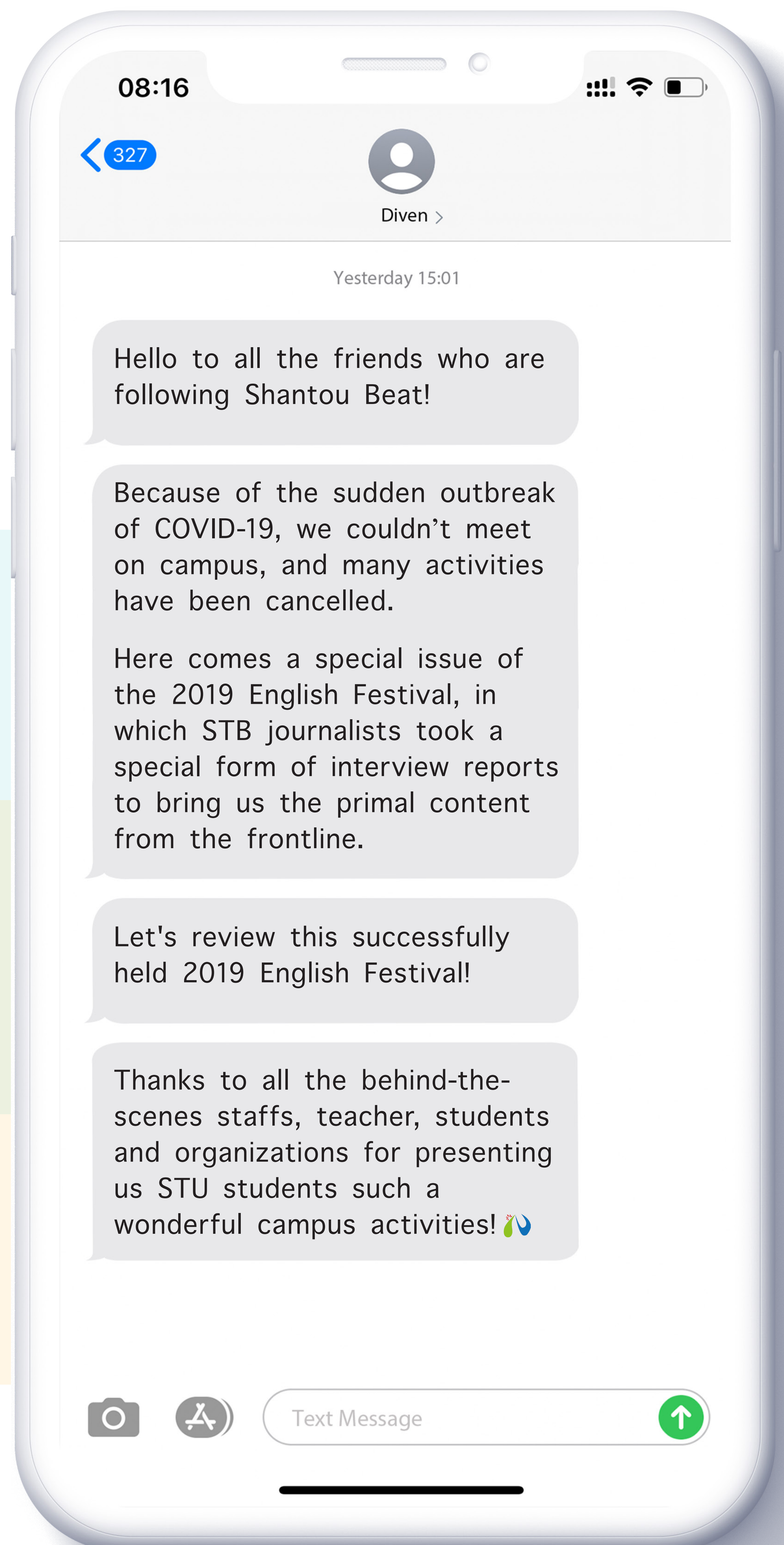

And as for the skills, I think talking to yourself and thinking in English are good ways to prepare, because you only have 5 seconds to think about the question and to respond. So it is very important for you to practice every day even though you are not in the contest. To force yourself to think in English, and express your opinions in English.
