24-26 April 2020 Shantou, China



The English Language Center of the College of Liberal Arts, Shantou University, is pleased to announce that it is accepting proposals for the 10<sup>th</sup> edition of its Biennial ELT International Conference to be held in Shantou, Guangdong, China from the 24<sup>th</sup> to the 26<sup>th</sup> of April 2020.

In alternating years, the English Language Center of Shantou University brings together hundreds of ELT professionals from many countries for fruitful discussions on their research results and teaching experiences. English teachers, trainers, curriculum developers, specialists in the didactics of ELT, researchers and many others gather to share their experiences in diverse realms of English language teaching and learning. Spanning three days, the conference provides a unique platform for innovative ideas and new voices. It also offers excellent opportunities to meet with prominent ELT theorists, including distinguished guest plenary speakers from top universities in China, Australia, Canada and the UK.

**Conference Theme** 

The theme for the Conference is Converging & Diverging Paths: ELT in a Changing Environment. Economic growth and

globalization result in higher demands for ELT at all levels of education. English becomes increasingly important not only as a fundamental tool for global interconnectedness but also for the overall formation of students. ELT teachers and researchers rise to the challenge by implementing innovative policies and curriculums, developing fresh approaches to assessment, modernizing teacher training, incorporating the latest technological developments and more. Meanwhile, research in pedagogy, linguistics, psychology and neurology yields a plethora of new conceptions that promote a reassessment of previously fixed principles and dogmas, thus provoking productive conflicts of ideas. The conference aims to offer a high-level academic forum for debate on these diverging conceptions and a proper place to find their points of convergence.





#### **Conference Subthemes**

International Conference welcomes original research papers, classroom (best practice) papers, workshops and poster presentations addressing issues that are relevant to, but are not limited to the following strands:

- ELT and global competence
- ELT methods and pedagogy
- Language testing and assessment
- ELT teacher education and cognition
- Content and language integrated learning
- Technology-enhanced ELT
- Learner needs and autonomy
- ELT and critical literacies
- ELT and translation

#### Submission Guidelines

- Each presenter/participant must register online.
- The presenter should submit a proposal online. Each presenter may submit only one proposal for the conference.
- Title of presentation: no more than 20 words.
- Proposal: 200-300 words, written in a single paragraph.
- Bio statement of the presenter(s): 80-100 words.

#### **Special Remarks**

- The working language of this conference is English.
- Paper presentation: 20 minutes + 5 minutes for questions and answers.
- Workshop/poster presentation: 90 minutes.
- Colloquium session: 90 minutes. 3-4 presentations that address one conference strand.

Selection Criteria

All proposals will be blind reviewed and selected by the Academic Review Committee based on relevance to the conference theme,

originality, quality, and contribution to ELT. The Committee reserves the right to edit all the submitted proposals.
